

DOG BOARDING INSTRUCTIONS ~

I welcome your canine family member into my home for a visit! To make his/her (and my) experience a truly happy one, please provide the following:

Please make sure your fur friend has had a recent bath, short toenails that have been filed blunt so that there are not sharp cut edges, and current flea protection when relevant.

Proof and copy of lab report from (Antech or IDEXX) via your Veterinarian of annual **Fecal Exam including Ova/Parasites and Giardia (ELISA.)**

Immunizations are good for 7 years; I do not require nor promote excessive vaccinations but want copy from Vet of vaccine history, digital copies only please. Include License #number on client questionnaire form. No need to wear license tag, your fur friend should just have a collar, ID tag with your contact information.

NOTIFY YOUR VET THAT I WILL BE CARING FOR YOUR DOG.

PLEASE BRING WITH YOUR FUR FRIEND:

Authorization to place urgent/emergency Veterinary care on your Credit Card or account based on a Medical Directive if you are gone over a week and or out of state. Out of country, credit card must be on file with me or your Veterinarian.

Any special medical needs (allergies for instance) and appropriate medical history. Medications or Supplements and instructions, if any.

Dog Food (labeled w <u>Brand</u>) in *Tupperware* (tall container preferred, not flat) (must bring <u>extra</u> in case you're delayed.) Measure/Scoop and any special instructions.

Harnesses are recommended for all breeds, please bring one. Please don't bring or leave, leashes, kennels, dog beds, bowls or blankets.

All dogs **must be flea free** and freshly bathed for boarding. Stinky dogs will be bathed at your expense. Charges are based on breeds, size or special needs. (Fleas found on your dog will be treated at your expense.)
